Several tips on how to minimize slow play were; splitting up, one cart looks for a lost ball rather than all four players, passenger keeps score and the first cart to arrive at the tee box goes first.

It was suggested that a volunteer from the WCWGA serve as ranger to keep things moving. It was also suggested that players record their start and finish time and on what hole they start directly on the scorecard. This would help players gain an awareness of their times.

Participants reached agreement that the membership needs to revisit “splitting up” and focusing on it being mandatory should one player deem it necessary. The idea of the yellow flags has been tabled for the immediate future.
